Arc Flash Safety – America Society of Safety Engineers (ASSE)

“Arc Flash Protection is an important concern for those who perform electrical work. An Arc Flash Protection Program is designed to save lives, prevent disabling injuries, and prevent damage to plants, buildings and equipment. Based on NFPA 70E, which is now the new standard for meeting OSHA training requirements (See: CFR 1910.331-335), Thomas Black of Safer Worker Systems, Inc. & Mike Votaw of Votaw Electric will present an overview of what is needed to comply with this new standard. They will discuss definitions, general requirements, establishing safe work conditions, working on or near live parts, safe approach distances, training requirements, and other current information related to Arc Flash and Electrical Safety.”
