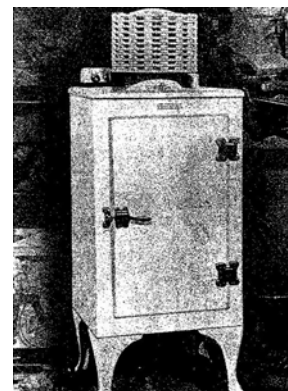


# HISTORICAL DISPLAYS OF AREA'S ELECTRICAL / ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS
